- B. The Commission reviewed the Memorial & Sports Center Calendars for the month of May 2018.
- C. The maintenance report for the month of April 2018 was reviewed by the commission.

Parks & Recreation Foundation:

Chairman Huhn mentioned that the Golf Tournament was a great event. The Foundation had a meeting to see what went wrong and how we can improve the numbers for next year. We will be sending out surveys to the players from this year to get their feedback. Once we get the surveys back we can review the input and make the necessary changes.

Manger's Report:

- A. Hawthorne Pool/ Memorial Center/ Sports Center – We are actively taking registration for the pool. 30% of the classes are full. June 16, 2018 is the last day to register at the Memorial Center and pay with a credit card. The remodel is

coming along well. Women's restroom is completely done. We are still working on the men's restroom.

Sports Center – We are conducting interviews for the Sports Specialist position. Hope to have someone in place soon.

- B. Homeless Taskforce. - I will be meeting with the consultant to see what strategies they came up with. Once they give us their input we will decide what will work for Hawthorne.
- C. Art Show- Helene Trudeau the South Bay Regional Arts Coordinator stop by to give the commission some helpful information regarding hosting the upcoming Art Show. Discussion followed.
- D. Department Achievements - The Summer Park Program will be adding another component which will be a free lunch program. We will start off serving 25 lunches Monday – Friday at each park for 8 weeks.

Futsal Court at Memorial Court goals were worn out. The courts were closed for 3 weeks. The courts were open as of today.

- E. Dodger RBI – Parent meeting for T-Ball & 5 Pitch will be June 4, & June 6, 2018.
