Director's Report:

Manager's Report:

- A. - Hawthorne Pool/ Memorial Center/ Sports Center - Swimming lessons went well. After 10 weeks we served over 3,000 participants at our pool with very few complaints. Maintenance will begin working on the second phase after August 17th.

Currently our new Recreation Specialist is working on cleaning up the rates and fees for the Sports Center. By the end of the year everyone will be paying the correct fees.
- B. - Youth Sports – Our flyers for Futsal have been sent to the Hawthorne School District. This year we will be adding two days of clinics for the participants.

C. - New Programs – We are offer a new program non-competitive swim program called Hawthorne Hammer Heads. We've received lots of inquiries regarding this program.

Commissioner's Discussion Action Item:

Chairman Huhn asked that the commission focus on what we are able to do with regards to the Art Show. Some of the things that were discussed early may not be doable due to the lack of resources. Discussion followed.
