Directors Report:

- A. Memorial Park Tot Lot - The tot lot was well received. There are a lot of families using the Tot Lot. We decided to add bleachers near the Tot Lot so that parents could sit and watch their kids.
- B. Holiday Home Decorating Contest – We received several entries this year. I think promoting the event on the Bulletin Board on the Blvd really helped.

- C. Bicentennial Park Project – This project is moving along. They are 2 weeks behind schedule due to the rainy days. I posted some pictures on Facebook if you want to see how far they've gotten.
- D. Mural Donation (Holly Park) – The City Attorney's Office is working on a waiver for all Artists to sign before doing any Murals on city property.
- E. Holly Park Security Cameras – The Hawthorne Police Department installed several cameras in Holly Park to help monitor the illegal activity. The cameras are in real time and they also record.
- F. LA Galaxy – On the Anniversary of opening the Futsal Courts at Memorial Park LA Galaxy came out and ran Futsal clinics for the kids. They also rented a Food truck to feed the kids that participated.
- G. Landscape City Hall Parking Lot - We are re-landscaping the planters in City Hall Parking Lot. Parkwood is doing the work and we are buying the tree.
