- C. Hawthorne Pool Repairs - The Parks & Recreation Foundation has agreed to work with us on doing some repairs at the pool. Currently we are working with maintenance to get some quotes on specific repairs.
- D. Girls Sports Clinics – The Recreation Department is adding a few new girls programs. This will consist of Volleyball, Futsal and Basketball. If you know any girls between the ages of 9-12 and are interested in participating please let me know.
- E. Park Cameras – All Hawthorne Parks have cameras except Holly Glen. Our IT Department is currently working on installing cameras at Memorial Park. Hopefully Holly Glen Park is next on the list.
- F. Ramona Park Mural – The Mural Dedication at Ramona Park went well. Velvet Marshall did a great job. There was a nice crowd of people there supporting her and they even had lite appetizers for everyone to enjoy.
- G. Jim Thorpe Futsal Court - Look like the construction will begin to turn the Tennis Courts into Futsal Courts at Jim Thorpe Park in November. They should be completed by mid-December.
