- Must have income from VA Pension or SSDI to qualify.
- Rent is assessed at 30% of income.

## Supportive Services

- Homeless Prevention Assistance Assist veterans who have started the eviction process.
- Rapid Re-housing
   Assist homeless veterans in securing independent housing.
