HAWTHORNE CA - The City of Hawthorne is hosting a general municipal election on November 8. During the upcoming election, Hawthorne voters can vote to elect two members of the City Council, a City Clerk and a City Treasurer. Residents will also have the opportunity to vote on Ballot Measure I, a proposed city charter.

To vote in the upcoming State election, registration is required by October 24. To be eligible to vote, one must be over the age of 18, a resident of the United States of America, and live within the Hawthorne City limits. Residents can confirm their registration status and register to vote at <https://registertovote.ca.gov/>.

To vote by mail, voters can either mail their ballot, drop off their ballot at a ballot drop box or drop off at an LA County vote center. All ballots postmarked by Election Day and received in 7 days will be processed. To vote in person, voters can visit a local certified voting center.
