Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be income eligible (see chart)
- Must have good credit (no judgments, collections or recent bankruptcies)
- Must be able to make a small down payment
- Must demonstrate veteran status and honorable discharge (DD214)
- Must be a first time homebuyer
- Additional requirements may apply
