HVC Program

The Hollywood Veteran Center is a transitional housing program for homeless OEF, OIF, and OND veterans who struggle with financial, mental health, and/or substance abuse issues that impede employability. HVC provides veterans with the necessary tools, referrals and connections to government and community resources.

Services Offered and Resident Expectations

After being admitted to the program, veterans are expected to participate in the following;

- Weekly case management.
- Daily attendance and participation of scheduled clinical groups focused on anger management, relapse prevention, and cognitive behavioral techniques.
- Community chore– assigned and rotated weekly.
- Random urinalysis and room inspections.
- Permanent housing and financial planning.
