



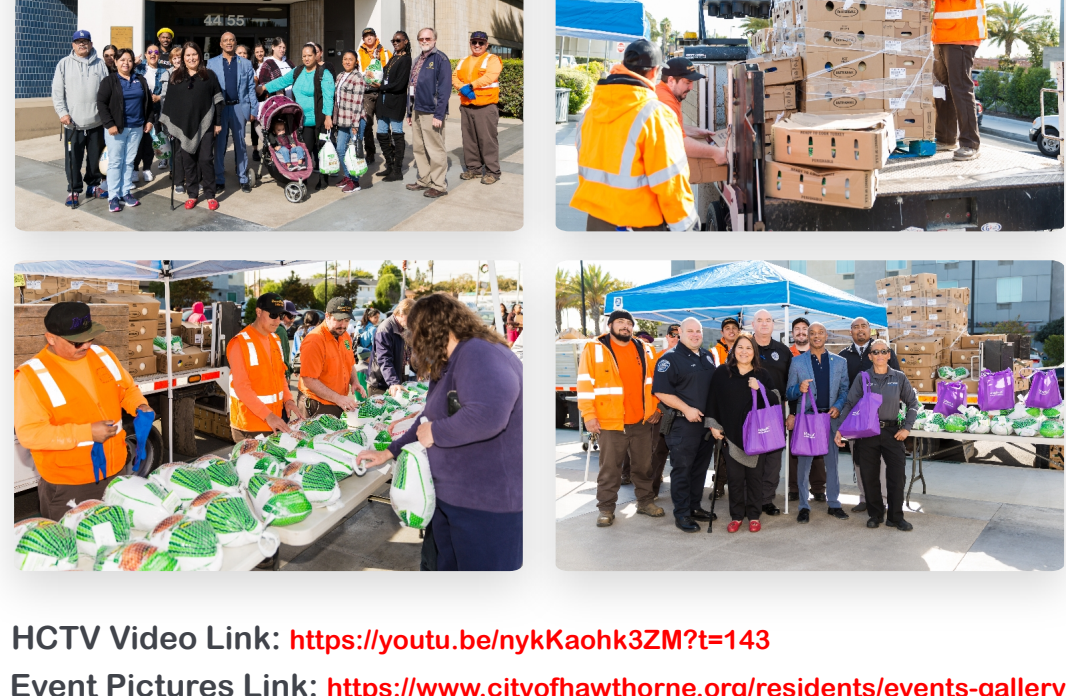

Operation Gobble 11/17/22

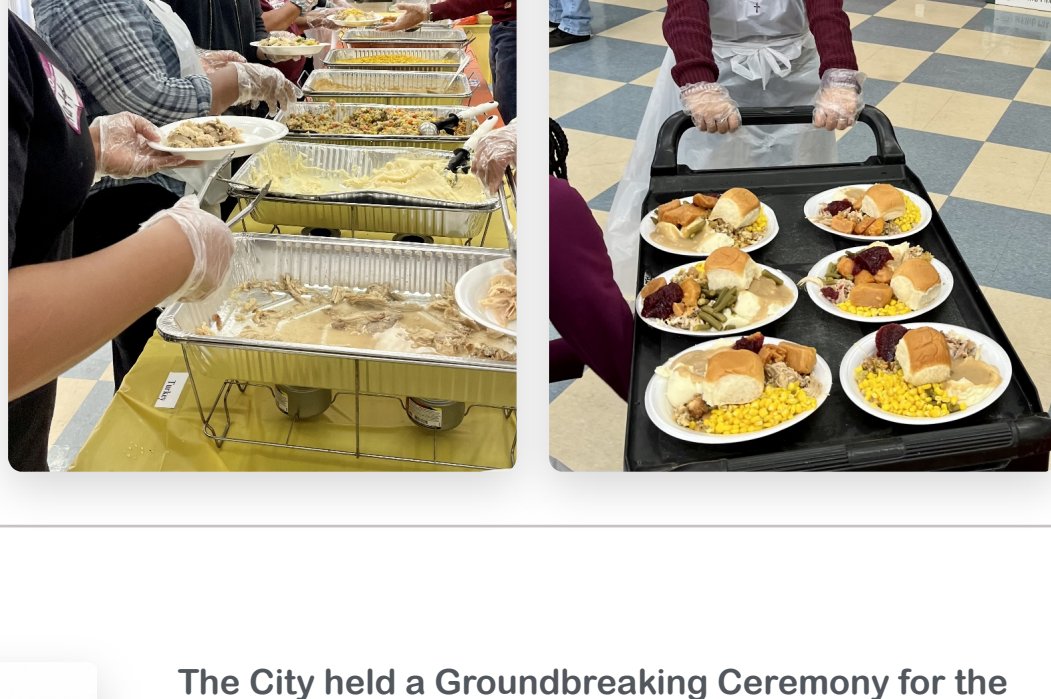

Bridge Housing Project 11/30/22



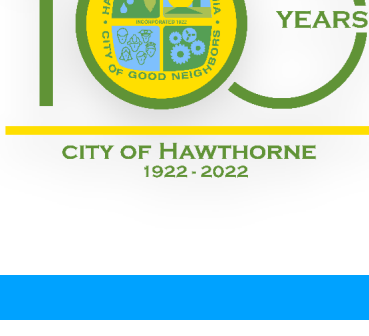
The City held a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Bridge of Hope - Community Housing Project. The 3800 sqft City-owned lot is located at 131st St and Simms Ave, will offer (12-15) 64 sqft insulated shelter units. The ideal length of stay is between 90-180 days. A service provider who will bring onsite case management, job training, three daily meals and connection to additional services will operate the site. This is a temporary site that will initially run for 3 years or until all available funds have been exhausted. More info in the video link below...

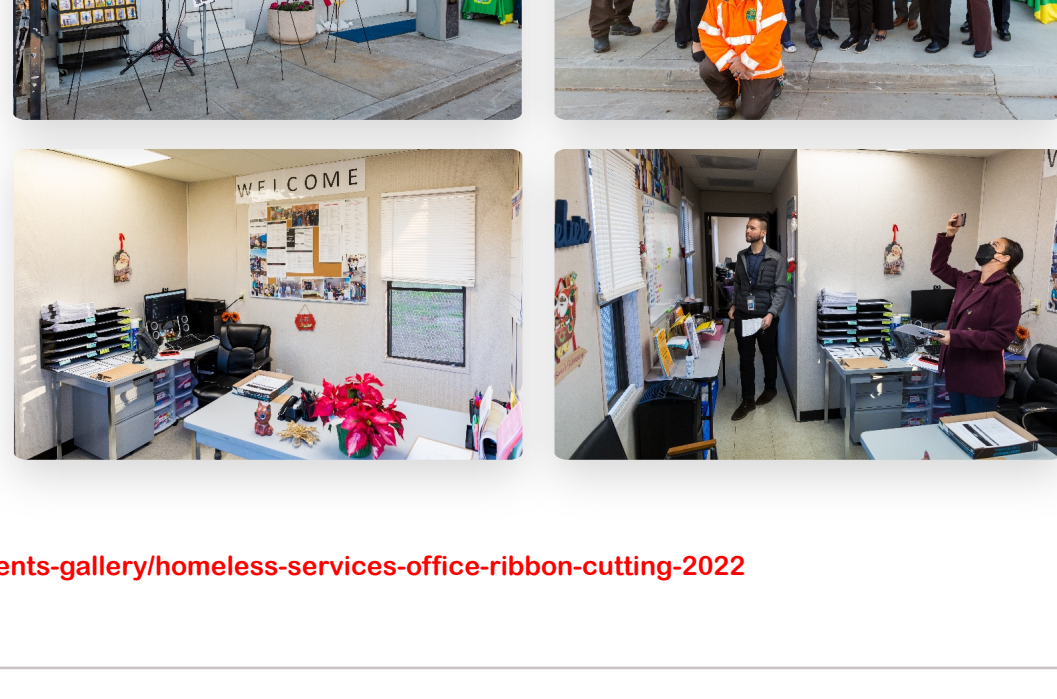

Newly-Elected City Officials 12/13/22

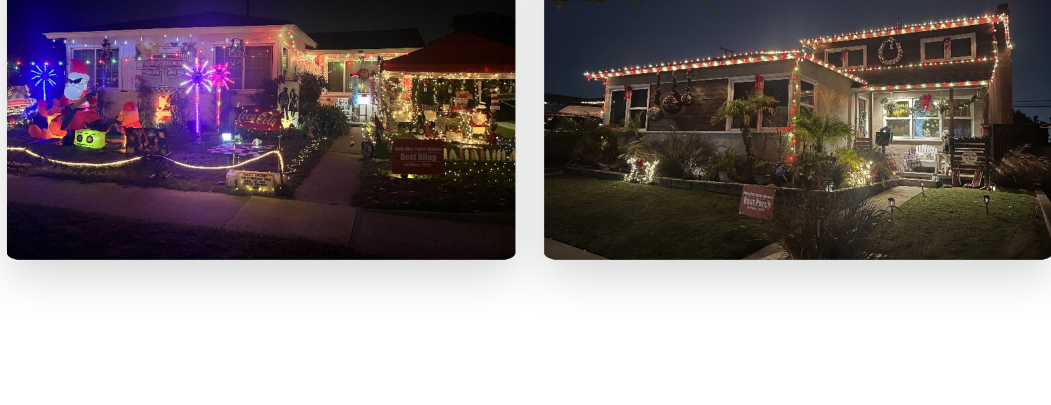

Katrina Manning received the most amount of votes with 4,146 securing her seat on the Dias. Incumbent Alex Monteiro reclaimed his council seat with 3,619 total votes. Dayna Williams-Hunter became our new City Clerk replacing Dr. Paul Jimenez after serving his full term, and Marie Poindexter-Hornback won a close race to become our new City Treasurer, who pulled out the victory over Gregory Fallon! 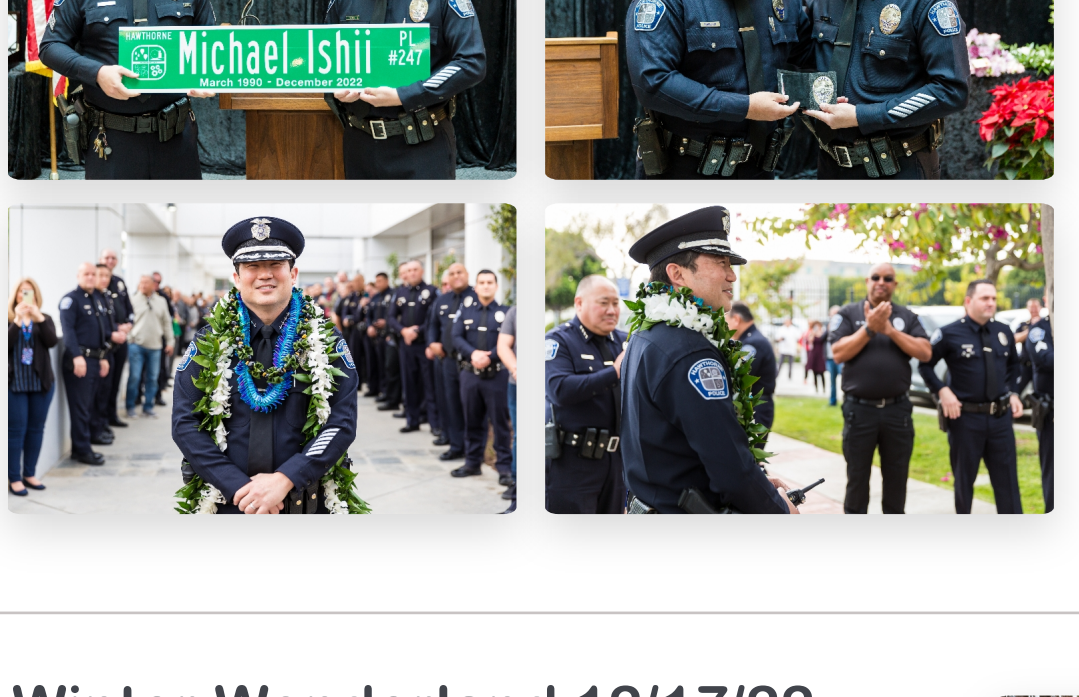

Police Chief Retires 12/15/22

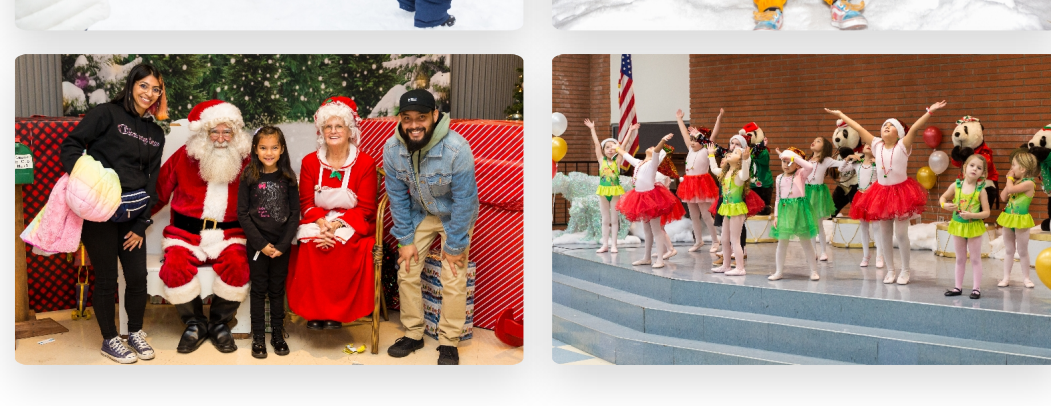

Thank you Michael Ishii for all your years of service in the City and keeping the community safe!

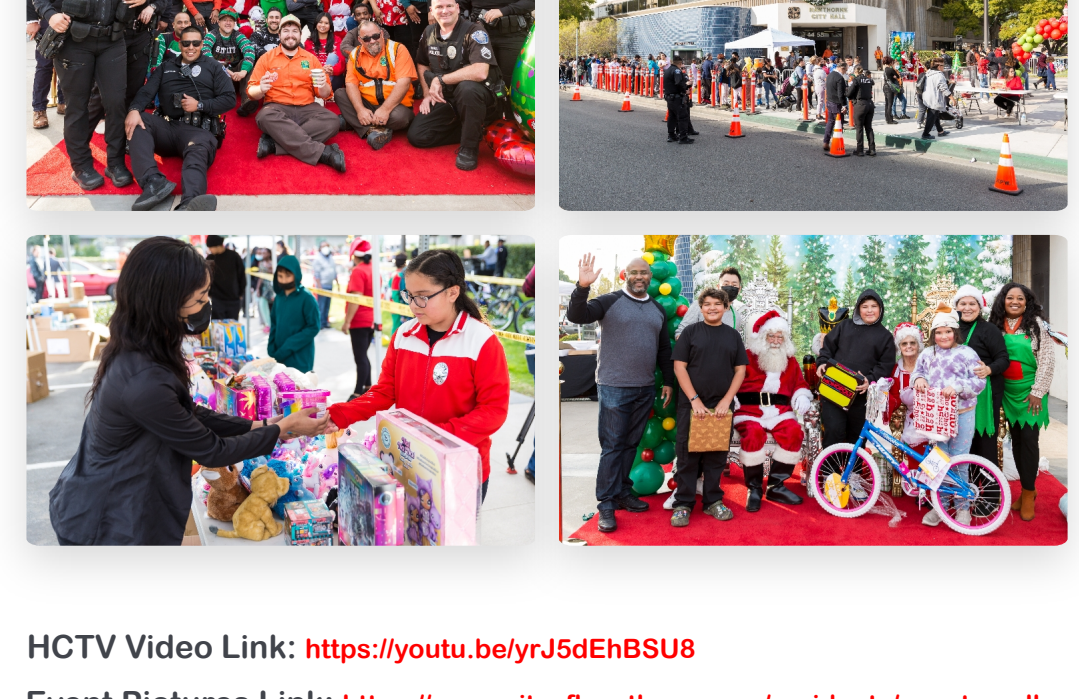
Winter Wonderland 12/17/22

Good Neighbors Toy Giveaway 12/22/22



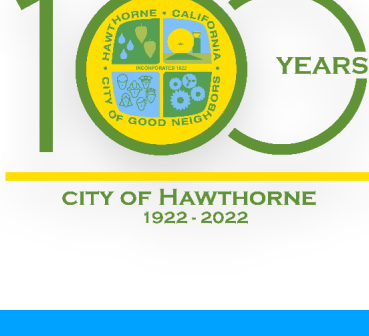
