One check, in the amount of \$500,000 went to the City of Hawthorne to fund the Hawthorne Affordable Housing Improvement Projects. The second check in the amount of \$500,000 went to the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) here in Hawthorne for workforce development and activities, and the third check in the amount of a little over \$235,000 went to the Veterans of Foreign War Post 2075 for their rehabilitation project.

slot cars, but also teaches them concepts of how an electric slot car works. They compare them to how an actual life-size car operates. To see what other classes the Hawthorne Community Services Department






