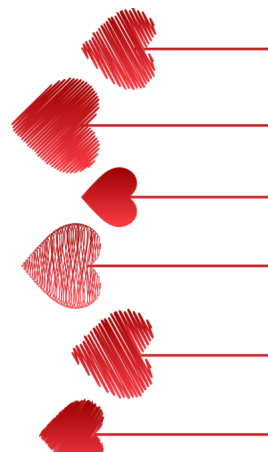

## COVID Testing 1/18/22

FREE COVID testing opened up at the Betty Ainsworth parking lot on January 18th! As the Omicron variant surges throughout Los Angeles, significant testing shortages are magnifying the strain on families and individuals across the region. A free COVID-19 testing site, hosted by Reliant Health Services will be available to the community for a minimum of six months, which began on January 18th. If you would like to get tested, the site will be open Tuesdays – Saturdays, 9AM-4PM at the Betty Ainsworth Sports Center parking lot located at 3851 W. El Segundo Blvd. Walk-ups are welcome. Testing is available to all ages. No appointment required but encouraged, and can be made at [relianthealthservices.com/hawthorne](https://relianthealthservices.com/hawthorne) Pre-register for your COVID testing by scanning the QR code to make the process quicker when you arrive.
