SB 1383: What You Should Know

Senate Bill 1383 requires the City of Hawthorne to adopt a mandatory organics participation ordinance to go into effect by January 1, 2022. For the following two years, outreach and education efforts will be made to ensure everyone is compliant. Beginning January 1, 2022, Hawthorne residents will use the green curbside cart for green waste and other organic waste, including food, food-soiled paper and yard clippings.

This new requirement is part of a Mandatory Recycling Ordinance that ensures the recycling of food and green waste materials, which were previously destined for landfill.



Housing

The City of Hawthorne Council has agreed to adopt a resolution becoming Associate Member of CSCDA Community Improvement Authority (CSCDA's Affiliate JPA). In partnership with Standard-Faring Essential Housing, the City of Hawthorne presents Millennium South Bay as a target property to convert from market rate into the Workforce Housing Program. The Millennium property has 230 units, deluxe pool area, resident lounges, fitness center, co-working space and a 3140 sq. ft. restaurant space. Stay tuned for additional details...

Animal Control



The Los Angeles County Veterinary Public Health is investigating a rapidly spreading outbreak of canine influenza H3N2 (CIV H3N2) in local dogs. This is an infectious and vaccine preventable respiratory disease that can spread rapidly in unvaccinated dogs.

Doggy day cares, dog parks and boarding kennels face increased risk of spreading disease due to the close interactions.

It is recommended that dogs be vaccinated for both canine influenza H3N2 and Leptospirosis (another disease spreading in LA County).

What is Canine Influenza & How Can My Dog Get It?
Canine influenza (also known as dog flu) is a contagious respiratory disease in dogs caused by specific Type A influenza viruses known to infect dogs.
Signs of Canine Influenza:
Cough, runny nose, fever, lethargy, eye discharge, and reduced appetite.

What is Leptospirosis & How Does My Dog Get It?

A bacterial infection that spreads through the bloodstream. Dogs can get leptospirosis from puddles or bodies of water that carry urine from infected wildlife. The bacteria infiltrate a dog's body by burrowing into their skin. Canine leptospirosis can be a serious, life-threatening disease.

Signs of Leptospirosis: Sudden fever and illness, sore muscles; reluctance to move, stiffness in muscles and legs, shivering, weakness, depression and lack of appetite.
