Engineering/Public Works Projects



- Engineering and Public Works Departments are currently working on doing upgrades to Holly Park, Jim Thorpe Park and Holly Glen Park. Stay tune to see what upgrades are coming soon to these locations.
- Striping is continuing on Prairie Avenue between Imperial Avenue and Marine Avenue. This is Phase 2 in the Prairie Avenue Improvement Project scheduled to be complete in February 2022.
- There is a railway crossing improvement project happening on Aviation Boulevard that's scheduled to be complete in Summer of 2022.
- Traffic Signal Upgrades are happening at the intersections of El Segundo and Ramona, and on El Segundo and Inglewood. The upgrades consist of new controllers, timing, lighting of the intersections, and make it all ADA compliant.

neighborhood safety

Police



- The Hawthorne Police Department completed two hours of in-service training for all officers and sergeants focused on mental health related issues that officers face daily.
- Deployed the Community Trailer to the Holly Park neighborhood with support of our Patrol staff and Bike Detail.
- A "Ride to Live" motorcycle safety course was held in partnership with Torrance PD and El Segundo PD. Twenty-three civilian motorcycle enthusiasts joined the course.
- HPD has had success with their e-bike program. There are 12 officers trained for bicycle patrol and they have eight e-bikes for everyday use. These bikes can travel up to 70 miles and up to 28mph on a single charge!
