

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS CHECKLIST

1. WHAT YOU NEED FOR YOUR HOUSE DURING AN EARTHQUAKE

- Cases of water to last your family 1 month (in addition, a 55-gallon tank for water)
- Enough toilet paper to last a month for your family
- 400-600 garbage bags for the toilets and trash
- Flash lights/batteries to last 1 month for every room and exit door
- A generator with gasoline (for the refrigerator and lights)
- Can goods and a regular can opener
- First Aid kit and tampons for gashes, tape, and scissors
- Barbeque/Charcoal to cook with if the gas is off (Only outside)
- Paper Plates, Napkins, Plastic Forks and spoons to last a month
- Fire extinguisher for the house and car
- Keep a set of clothes/tennis shoes next to your bed/tennis shoes for car
- Heavy gloves for house and car to move glass that breaks
- Flares for your car
- A whistle if you are stuck under falling wood and can't get up

PLEASE BUY THESE ITEMS SO YOU/YOUR FAMILY ARE PREPARED FOR A DISASTER

Tips: Please note that the trash bags can be utilized for the restrooms. In the event that the water supply is unavailable, place a trash bag in the toilet for waste disposal, and remember to dispose of it appropriately afterwards.
