1. DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS.

1. The Successful Proposer(s) shall be responsible for the installation of Energy Efficient LED lighting in Hawthorne Police Department.. RFP to the City site required. Delivery fee is to be included as part of the proposal amount. Delivery locations include, without limitation, on the sites stated below:

2. The Successful Proposer(s) shall be responsible for making all deliveries and installation required under the final Professional Services Agreement(s) Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time (“PST”) A mutually agreed upon delivery and installation schedule will be included in the final Professional Services Agreement(s). The Successful Proposer(s) shall notify the City of any unexpected events that may delay or prevent the part deliveries from being made at the agreed upon time.
3. The Successful Proposer(s) shall ensure that all personnel responsible for delivering products pursuant to the terms and conditions of the final Professional Services Agreement(s) conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner when on City premises, including, without limitation, wearing company apparel with visible photo identification and adhering to the City’s policies prohibiting the use of alcohol, drugs and tobacco.
4. Contractor and personnel must undergo a Police Department background check and must be approved before awarding the project.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION REGARDING PROPOSALS:

3.1 Proposal Submission:

Proposers shall prepare and submit one (1) original and two (2) copies of the Proposal(s) by 1:30p.m. PST, on December 17th, 2024. All Proposals shall be signed by an authorized agent of the Proposer, and must be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked as RFP along with the name and address of the Proposer and the closing date and time for submission of Proposals. Time is of the essence, and any Proposal received after the above-referenced time and date for submittal, whether by mail or otherwise, will be rejected and returned to the Proposer unopened. It is the sole responsibility of the Proposer to ensure that its Proposal(s) is received before the submittal deadline and postmarks will not be accepted in lieu of this requirement. However, nothing in this RFP precludes the City from extending the deadline for submission

of Proposals, or from requesting additional information at any time during the Proposal evaluation process.

3.2 Right of City to Reject Proposals:

The City reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals or to waive, at its discretion, any irregularity which the City deems reasonably correctable or otherwise not warranting rejection of a Proposal.

Price, response time, quality of service, and qualifications will be considered when evaluating the proposals. City of Hawthorne does not intend to award a contract fully on the basis of any response made to the proposal.

City of Hawthorne reserves the right to consider proposals for modifications at any time before a contract is awarded, and negotiations would be undertaken with that contractor whose proposal is deemed to best meet the City's specifications and needs.

3.3 General Instructions and Information:

A. Content Requirements. In order for Proposals to be considered for award by the City, all of the following conditions must be satisfied:

1. Proposals must be submitted in accordance with the standards and specifications set forth in this RFP and contain all required attachments, including, without limitation, a signed and completed Signature Affidavit.
2. Proposals must be complete and specific unto themselves. For example, "See *Enclosed Manual*" will not be considered an acceptable response.
3. Proposals shall be concise and to the point. Costly bindings, color plates, glossy brochures, etc. are not necessary or recommended.
4. All information, statements, letters and other documentation and attachments required by this RFP must be included in the original Proposal and each copy thereof.

6. CERTIFICATION OF OFFERER/BIDDER REGARDING DEBARMENT

By submitting a proposal under this solicitation, the bidder or offerer certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred or suspended by any Federal department or agency from participation in this transaction.

CERTIFICATION OF LOWER TIER CONTRACTORS REGARDING DEBARMENT

The successful bidder, by administering each lower tier subcontract that exceeds \$25,000 as a “covered transaction”, must verify each lower tier participant of a “covered transaction” under the project is not presently debarred or otherwise disqualified from participation in this assisted project. The bidder is to provide a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number. The bidder will accomplish this by:

If the City of Hawthorne later determines that a lower tier participation failed to disclose to a higher tier participant that it was excluded or disqualified at the time it entered the covered transaction, the City of Hawthorne may pursue any available remedies, including suspension and debarments of the non-compliant participant.

Cover Letter:

Each Proposal must contain a signed cover letter which, in one (1) page or less, describes the Proposer's company and summarizes the Proposer's qualifications, experience and vision for providing the vehicle and equipment parts and supplies.

RFP Signature Affidavit:

Each Proposal must contain a signed and completed RFP Signature Affidavit which is attached to this RFP. The RFP Signature Affidavit must be signed by an authorized representative of the Proposer's company. Signature authorization on the RFP Signature Affidavit shall constitute a warranty, the falsity of which shall entitle the City to pursue any and all remedies authorized by law, including, without limitation, termination of any Professional Services Agreement(s) resulting therefrom. Receipt of all Addenda to this RFP, if any, must be acknowledged on the bottom of the RFP Signature Affidavit.

Proposal Table of Contents:

Proposals shall include a comprehensive table of contents that identifies submitted material

by sections 1.0-10.0 in the order listed herein and any subsections thereof with sequential page numbers.

Business Profile:

Proposals shall include a clear and concise narrative which identifies the Proposer's ability to provide the services specified in this RFP.

The Business Profile must include an overview of the business structure and operation of the Proposer's company. The company overview should include, at a minimum the following items:

1. **Company Overview:** Provide a brief overview of your company, including its history, experience, and any relevant certifications or accreditations.
2. **Experience and Qualifications:** Demonstrate your experience in providing lighting services to municipal or government organizations. Include references and examples of similar projects.
3. **Product Offering:** Highlight any partnerships with major light manufacturers or distributors.
4. **Pricing and Cost Structure:** Present a comprehensive pricing structure, including costs for light supply, maintenance, repair services, and disposal. Provide pricing for individual services and any available package deals.
5. **Service Level Agreements (SLAs):** Outline the proposed SLAs for lighting supply, maintenance, repair, and disposal services. Include response times, turnaround times, and guarantees for emergency services.
6. **Environmental Considerations:** Describe your company's commitment to environmentally friendly practices, including light recycling initiatives or sustainable disposal methods.
7. **Implementation Plan:** Present a detailed plan for implementing the proposed services, including timelines, resource allocation, and any potential impact on the City's operations.

Statement of Qualifications. The Business Profile must include a statement of qualifications regarding the Proposer's ability to provide the City with Tires provided forth in this RFP. The statement of qualifications should include, at a minimum, all of the following items:

1. The physical address of all facilities from which any of the services set forth in this RFP will potentially be provided and the staff allocation at each such facility.

2. A detailed description of the Proposer's knowledge of the requirements pertaining to the provision set forth in this RFP including the years in business and experience providing automotive light, medium, and heavy duty parts and supplies. Demonstrate your experience in providing tire services to municipal or government organizations, particularly in managing fleet vehicles. Include references and examples of similar projects

3. Three (3) current references including company name, contact name, and phone number

Evidence of Insurance and Business Licenses:

All Proposers shall submit evidence of eligibility for all insurances required by the City of Hawthorne. Attached please find a sample liability insurance. Upon award of a Professional Services Agreement(s) the Successful Proposer(s) will have ten (10) calendar days to produce certificates of the required insurance, including a certified endorsement naming the City as an additional insured. Additional insurance should not be purchased until a Professional

Services Agreement(s) has been awarded.

In addition, all Proposers shall certify the possession of any and all licenses and/or certifications required for the provision set forth in this RFP including a City of Hawthorne Business License.

4. Requests for Clarification or Correction:

Proposers shall be responsible for meeting all of the requirements, specifications and conditions set forth in this RFP. If a Proposer discovers any ambiguity, conflict, discrepancy, omission or other error in this RFP, a written request for clarification or correction should be immediately submitted to the City. 4.1 RFP Addenda:

Any modifications to this RFP shall be made and distributed by written addendum. Addenda issued by the City interpreting or modifying any portion of this RFP shall be incorporated in the Proposal. The Addenda Cover Sheet shall be signed and dated by the Proposer and submitted to the City with the Proposal. Any oral communications concerning this RFP by City personnel are not binding on the City, and shall in no way modify this RFP or the obligations of the City or any Proposers.

5. Cost Proposals:

General Instructions and Requirements. The following is an outline of the general information and requirements applicable to price quotes:

1. The Warranty and Maintenance term and price quote shall be valid for a period of five (5) years after award date. An increase of raw material will be considered and adjusted for every year if needed.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Background:

This RFP is being issued by the City of Hawthorne for the procurement and installation of a new lighting system at the Hawthorne Police Department, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this document. The Hawthorne Police Department is located at 12501 Hawthorne Blvd, Hawthorne, CA 90250. The contract term shall be based on a lump sum price for equipment and labor to procure and install a new lighting system.

About City of Hawthorne Police Department Building:

The Hawthorne Police Department, constructed in 2002, is approximately 89,424 square feet. The building consists of offices, conference rooms, restrooms, common areas, lobby, and garage, shooting range, locker rooms, gym, jail and kitchen.

Existing interior and exterior lighting consists of a mixture of tube fluorescent, compact fluorescent and high-intensity discharge. Lighting controls include a combination of manual switch, occupancy sensor, dimmer switch, and lighting panel circuit breaker. See Attachment C. Existing Lighting Inventory for a detailed description of the existing equipment and system operation, including location, operating hours (M-F, Sat-Sun), and control method and equipment efficiency.

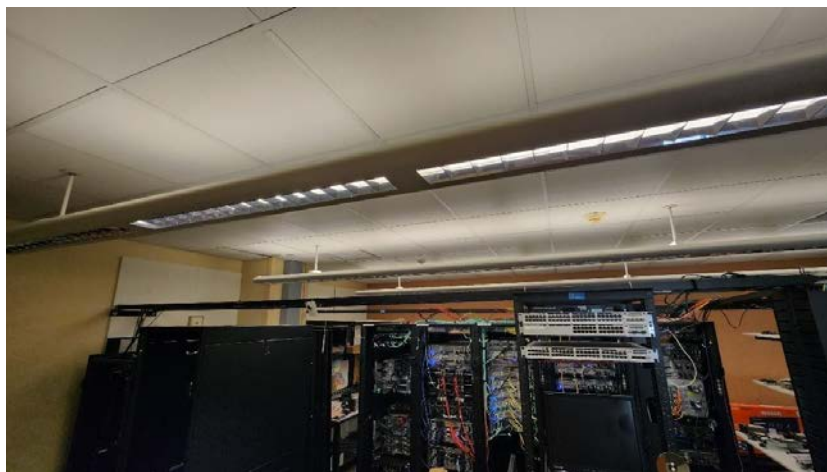

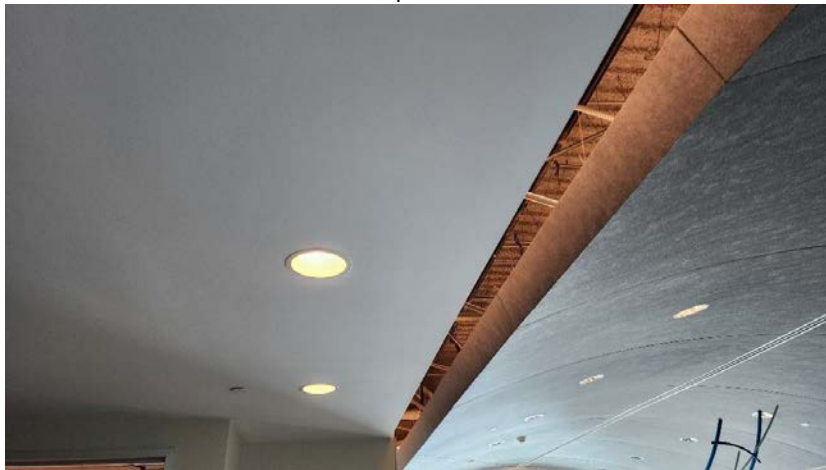

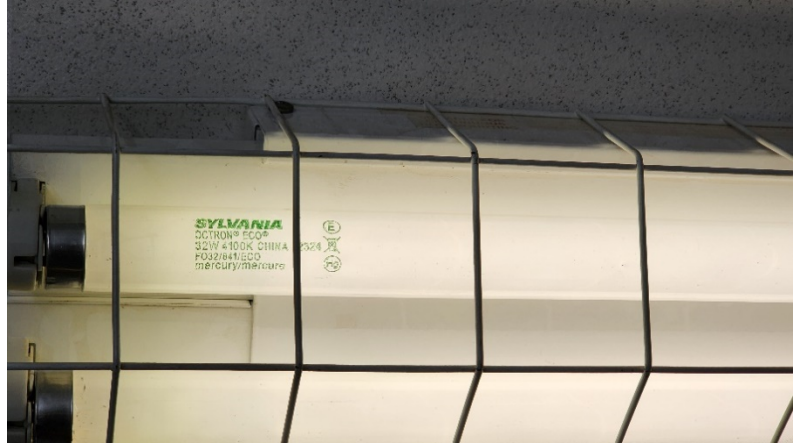

About City of Hawthorne’s Representatives:

All correspondence, communication and/or contact in regard to any aspect of this of this solicitation shall be in writing with the Public Works Manager Selena Acuna, at sacuna@cityofhawthorne.org; any such communication however is limited to clarifications regarding the RFP and both the questions and responses shall be available to all Service Providers.

Scope of Work:

The City of Hawthorne intends to enter into a contract with one qualified lighting contractor to furnish and install new LED lighting and lighting controls, as called for in the contract documents, specifications and the RFP.

See Attachment D. Proposed Lighting Inventory and Attachment E. Appendix E. Proposed Lighting Spec Sheets for a detailed description of the proposed equipment and system operation, including location, operating hours (M-F, Sat-Sun), control method and equipment efficiency.

Any proposals after that date and time will NOT be accepted. Each proposer shall submit Three (3) sets of the proposal

Wall or Ceiling Repairs:

If alterations to walls or ceilings are required to install new light fixtures or controls, new wall/ceiling color and texture should match existing.

City of Hawthorne Insurance Requirements:

REQUIRED INSURANCE COVERAGES

The service provider shall obtain and maintain at its expense, until completion of performance and acceptance by City, the following insurance placed with an insurer admitted to write insurance in California or a non-admitted insurer on California’s List of Eligible Surplus Lines Insurers (LESLI) and having a rating of or equivalent to A: VIII by A.M. Best Company.

Automobile Liability

Automobile Liability (equivalent in coverage scope to ISO form CA 00 01 06 92) in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 combined single limit per accident for bodily injury and property damage covering Auto Symbol 1 (Any Auto). If an automobile is not used in connection with the services provided by the consultant, the consultant should provide you with a written request for a waiver of this requirement.

Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability

Worker's Compensation as required by the California Labor Code and Employer's Liability in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 per accident to comply with Attachment B.

REQUIRED INSURANCE DOCUMENTATION

a. Certificate of Insurance

The contractor must provide you with a Certificate of Insurance evidencing the required insurance set forth above. The Certificate Holder must be the "City of Hawthorne", and the Certificate Holder's address must be the address of your Department.

b. Endorsements

In addition to the Certificate of Insurance, the consultant must provide the following endorsements:

- 1) **Additional Insured endorsement to the general liability policy.** The "City of Hawthorne, its officials, employees, and agents" must be endorsed to the consultant's general liability policy as additional insureds on an endorsement equivalent to ISO forms CG 20 10 11 85 or CG 20 26 11 85.
- 2) **Cancellation notice endorsements.** Each policy must be endorsed to provide that the policy shall not be cancelled or non-renewed by either party or reduced in coverage or limits (except by paid claims) unless the insurer has provided the city with thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation ten (10) days for cancellation due to nonpayment of premium is acceptable.
- 3) **Primary and noncontributory coverage endorsements.** The general liability and professional liability policies must be endorsed to provide that each policy shall apply on a primary and noncontributing basis in relation to any insurance or self-insurance, primary or excess, maintained by or available to the City or its officials, employees, and agents.
- 4) If the contractor maintains broader coverage and/or higher limits than the minimums shown above, the Entity requires and shall be entitled to the broader coverage and/or the higher

Limits maintained by the contractor. Any available insurance proceeds in excess of the specified minimum limits of insurance and coverage shall be available to the Entity.

5) Self-Insured Retentions

Self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the Entity. At the option of the Entity, the Contractor shall provide coverage to reduce or eliminate such self-insured retentions as respects the Entity, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers; or the Contractor shall provide evidence satisfactory to the Entity guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigations, claim administration, and defense expenses. The policy language shall provide, or be endorsed to provide, that the self-insured retention may be satisfied by either the named insured or Entity.

WARRANTY

The bidder agrees that the supplies or services furnished resulting from this contract award shall be covered by the most favorable commercial warranties that the Bidder gives any customer for such supplies or services. A copy of this warranty must be furnished with this bid response package.

Attachment A: Pricing Schedule

Contractor(s) shall complete the Pricing Schedule below. The prices quoted to the City should be as low as, or lower than, those charged to the Contractor’s most favored customer for comparable quantities under similar terms and conditions, in addition to any discounts shall be fixed (for all items) for the term of the contract.

Attachment B: Insurance Requirements

Below you will find the City of Hawthorne's Insurance Requirements:

INSURANCE COVERAGE:

1. Liability coverage not less than \$1,000,000.00 per person and \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence for bodily injury, and property damage of at least \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence; or combined single limits of \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence.
2. Worker's Compensation.

SPECIAL INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. City of Hawthorne named as additional insured.
2. 30-day non-equivocal clause stating the insurance will not be cancelled or materially changed prior to written notification to the City Clerk of the City of Hawthorne.
3. Strike the equivocal line of your cancellation clause which reads "... endeavor to ..." and "but failure to mail such notice shall impose no obligation or liability of any kind upon the company."

ENDORSEMENT:

Notwithstanding any inconsistent expression in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, or any other endorsement now or hereafter attached thereto, or made a part thereof, the protection afforded by said policy shall:

1. Include the City of Hawthorne as an additional insured covering all operations of the insured or contractors and subcontractors or anyone acting on their behalf under the contract with the City for work in or about the said City, whether liability is attributable to the insured or the City. (To include the elected officials, appointed officials, and employees.)
2. Not be cancelled or changed, except by written notice to the City Clerk and City Attorney of the City of Hawthorne at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of such cancellation.
3. No exclusion relating to the risks of underground hazard, collapse, or explosion shall act to limit the benefits of coverage, as they shall apply to the City of Hawthorne as provided in this endorsement.
4. The insurance afforded the City, Boards, Officers, Agents and Employees shall be primary insurance and not contributing with any other insurance of the City.
